What Happens When You Follow the Rules

- ✓ Praise and Rewards: When you follow the rules, you'll be recognised and praised. This might be public praise or a quiet word from your teacher.
- ✓ You might earn house points, shout-outs, stickers or even a Proud Post a special note to take home.

What Happens If You Forget the Rules

Sometimes, we all forget the rules. When that happens, here's what we'll do:

- 1. Gentle Reminder: We'll remind you of the rule you're not following.
- 2. Caution: If you keep forgetting, we'll have a quiet talk to help you understand what needs to change.
- 3. Reflection Time: If needed, we'll ask you to take a short break to think about how to follow the rules better.

When Things Get Serious

If someone breaks the rules in a very big way (like hurting others or saying mean things), a teacher will talk to them right away. The teacher might also talk to their parents to help them understand what went wrong and how to fix it.
