Devices that take photographs

How to take a good photograph

Positioning: Is it obvious what the main subject of the photograph is?

Framing: How well is the subject matter framed?

Detail: Are you close enough that you can see the detail?

Keeping an image clear

1. Hold the camera really still
2. Take your time and don't rush
3. When you've pressed the capture button, count to three before you move

Whenever you see a photo, you should think "Is this real?".

Remember: Before taking anyone's photo, you should ask them if it's OK.

Camera Flash	A tool that provides extra light when conditions become too dark. A flash lights up the subject of the photo quickly, while the camera takes the photo.
