Haka is a traditional dance of the Maori people, it is used in sports in New Zealand.

New Skills

Freeze frame

Stillness can help create drama and tension in a dance.

Motif is a single or short phrase that is repeated

Dynamics is how the dancer moves. They help you accentuate the music you are dancing to, match the ebb and flow of the tempo and add a performance aspect to the **dance**.
