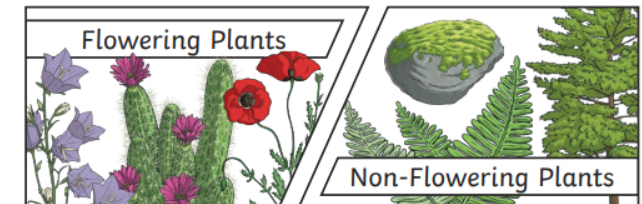
Habitats

The world can be divided into different regions, each with its own plants and animals. All living things are suited (or have adapted) to their environment and their surroundings. The animals and plants also depend on each other for survival. The study of the relationships between plants, animals, and their environments is known as **ecology**. The natural home of a plant, an animal or a group of animals is called its **habitat**.
