


Loops


Loops can be repeated continually, and these are known as infinite loops. In Scratch, this is called the repeat forever block.



Loops can also run a set number of times. These are known as count-controlled loops.

Key Vocabulary	
algorithm	A precise set of ordered instructions
code	The blocks that you have added. These are the commands for your sprite to follow.
decomposition	Breaking one big problem down into smaller, more manageable problems that can be tackled step by step.
modifying	Changing the code
repetition	Where actions or commands in programming are repeated. The repeating commands can also be referred to as a 'loop'.
