Filming Techniques

Close Up

- The camera is hand-held
- The camera is **close** to the subject
- The camera is moved to keep the subject in shot

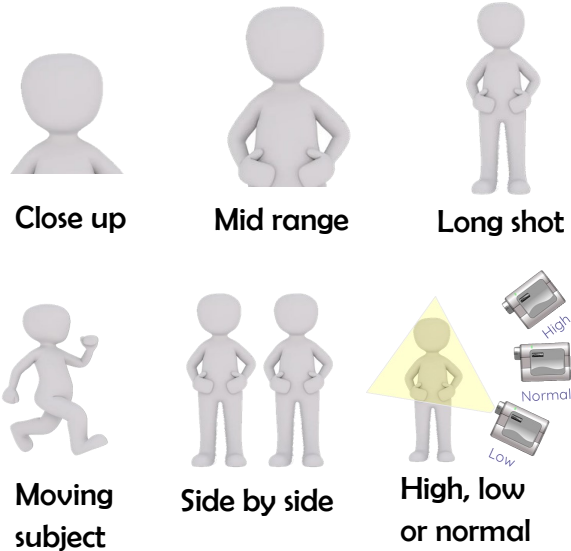
Panning

- The camera is hand-held
- The camera moves to show different things

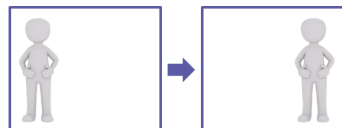
Talking Head

- The camera is in a fixed position to keep it still
- You can see the subject's head and body
- The presenter is talking

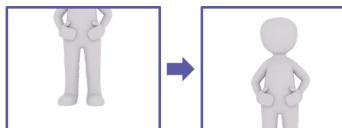
Filming Techniques



Pan: The camera position is fixed, but it is able to rotate from side to side.



Tilt: The camera position is fixed, but it is able to move up and down.



Key Vocabulary

High Angle	Makes a person look smaller than they are
Low Angle	Makes a person look bigger than they are
Normal angle	Makes a person look their actual size
Storyboard	A plan. Each section includes an image showing what the scene will look like and notes explaining the content.
Video	The recording, reproducing, or broadcasting of moving visual images.
Zoom	This allows for close up video so you can see the subject in greater detail. Be careful - too much zoom might make the subject blurry!
